- Acadience benchmark assessments start May 15
- NWEA MAP ELA and Math Fall 2022-Spr 2023
- Secondary literacy screener/process: Curriculum and Instruction Director, Kristen Albert, met with reps from Hope and LA to discuss/consider screener tools to propose to the district.

Student behavior data:

- Success Plan Update
 - Elementary 10 students have been on plans
 - 3/10 students are off plans
 - 3 students did get off plan, but were placed back on plans
 - 2 students are Tier 3
 - 5 students are Tier 2
 - Secondary 11 students have been on plans
 - 4 student have successfully removed off plans
 - 1 student at tier 3
 - 4 students at Tier 3 have been moved to Tier 2
 - 6 students are Tier 2
- Attendance (Truancy) update
 - -All students with 10+ absences received school and KentISD attendance communication (official

letters) in addition to in some cases phone calls, and/or parent meetings.

- 11 students were referred to Kent ISD. Two students were sent directly to the crisis intervention program. All other students referred have been sent truancy action letters. The 17 students noted in yellow will be monitored at the beginning of 2023-2024 and placed on attendance plans from the start of the year.
- -Students in green are recommended by the Kent ISD Truancy Officer as needing an Attendance Plan from the start of the 23-24.
- -Students not highlighted were identified as having extenuating circumstances (such as they transferred out, have 504 Plans, or are on Mkinney Vento)
